Muammar Gadafi was a brutal dictator and international terrorist who ruled the Socialist People's Republic of Libya from 1969 until 2011. During that period he was implicated in a number of terrorist atrocities in which Americans were killed, including the Lockerbie bombing

over Scotland, in which Pan Am Flight 103 between London (Heathrow) and New York (JFK) was destroyed by a bomb, killing all 243 passengers and 16 crew on board, and killing 11 people on the ground. 190 Americans were killed. It remains the deadliest terror attack in British history.

In 2003, Gaddafi accepted responsibility for the Lockerbie bombing and paid compensation to the families of the victims. In 2011, former Libyan Minister of Justice Mustafa Abdul Jalil claimed that Gaddafi had personally ordered the bombing.

A few years after Gaddafi took responsibility for killing all those innocent people, Hill International announced that they had done a deal with the Libyan government, ruled by Gaddafi, for a \$2 billion expansion of the Fateh University in Libya. Hill issued a press release celebrating the deal on August 24, 2007. The release was issued simultaneously from its Marlton, New Jersey, office -- and from Tripoli, the capital of Libya.

According to his biography, congressional candidate David Richter "spent 22 years at Hill International... Richter was the president of Hill from 2004 to 2014 and the CEO from 2014 to 2016."
